BYLAW NUMBER 180-01

REGARDING THE CLOSING OF ROAD

WHEREAS part of Terry-Fox Road, on a distance of 127,8 metres to the west, 6,95 metres to the north, 6,16 metres to the south and bordered to the east by the territory of the Town of Aylmer and having an approximate surface area of 752,9 square metres and has not been used as a road since it has been repaired as shown in the Municipality's cadastre;

WHEREAS this part of chemin Terry-Fox was abandoned many years ago;

WHEREAS interested parties do not object to its' closing;

WHEREAS a notice of motion was duly given at the regular meeting of council held October 9, 2001;

TO THIS END, it is ordered and statued by the Council of the Municipality of Pontiac as follows:

SECTION 1: the preamble to the present bylaw is an integral part of this bylaw as if noted in its entirety.

SECTION 2: to close said part of the road as described in the preamble of the present bylaw.
