**« MODIFICATION TO THE SUB-DIVISION BY-LAW NO. 178-01-
CONCERNING ROADS ENDING IN A CUL-DE-SAC »**

WHEREAS this council considers it appropriate and to be of public interest to modify sub-division by-law in order to control roads ending in a cul-de-sac;

WHEREAS the urban renewal committee recommends passing the proposed dispositions in this by-law;

AND RESOLVED THAT council decrees the following :

ARTICLE 1 :

To add to the to sub-division by-law no. 178-01, following article 3.5.5 :

Article 3.5.5.1 CUL-DE-SAC

The cul-de-sac may be used when it proves to be a practical and/or economical solution for accessing a lot which the form, relief or location does not lend itself to a continuous street.

Such a street must end in a cul-de-sac having a minimum exterior radius of fifteen meters (15 m).

ARTICLE 2 :

The present by-law will be in force following the accomplishment of formalities foreseen by Law.
