 $\rm \,^{<}$ BY-LAW WHICH DECREES A LOAN AND EXPENSE OF \$3,376,522.00 FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE WASTEWATER TREATMENT SYSTEM FOR THE VILLAGE OF QUYON $\rm ^{>}$

WHEREAS the notice of motion of the present by-law has been duly given during a special council meeting held on *March 26*, 2003.

This council decrees and gives a ruling on the following:

ARTICLE 1: Council is authorized to do or have the construction of the wastewater

treatment system done for the village of Quyon by using the lagoons technology according to estimates received by the firm Fondex Outaouais for the sum of \$3,376,522.00 dated January 15, 2002

including expenses, taxes and contingencies.

ARTICLE 2: Council is authorized to spend a sum not exceeding \$3,376,522.00 for

the purpose of the present by-law, this sum includes the work mentioned in article 1, as well as incidentals and contingencies.

<u>ARTICLE 3</u>: Council is hereby authorized to borrow a sum not exceeding

\$3,376,522.00 on a period of 20 years for the purpose of paying the

foreseen expenses by the present by-law.

<u>ARTICLE 4</u>: Council allocates to the reduction of the loan decreed to the present

by-law any subsidy or contribution that could be paid towards part of

the total of the foreseen expense mentioned in article 2.

ARTICLE5: Council allocates to the reduction of loan decreed to the present by-

law a sum not exceeding \$230,000.00 for this purpose from the

reserved surplus

ARTICLE 6: To provide for committeed expenses relative to 25% of the total of

interests and the reimbursement of the capital of annual payments, it is required and each year it will be deducted, during the term of the loan, on all the taxable real properties, a special tax at a sufficient rate

according to the value of each taxable real property in the

municipality, as it appears on the municipality's current assessment

role.

ARTICLE 7: To provide for committed expenses relative to 75% of the total of

interests and the reimbursement of the capital of annual payments, it is required and each year it will be deducted, during the term of the loan, on all taxable real properties served by the municipal sewage system, a special tax at a sufficient rate according to the value of each

taxable real property in the municipality, as it appears the

municipality's current assessment role.
