

Skating rinks: Closure of the 3 skating rinks

Municipality of Pontiac March 1, 2021 – 4:00 p.m.

What you need to know:

- As a preventive measure, the Municipality must **<u>permanently close</u>** the Luskville skating rink. The skating season for this winter is over on this ice surface.
- The skating rinks at the Davis Park (138 Soulières Crescent) and at the Quyon Recreational Park (2 Ferry Road) will be **temporarily closed**, until further notice.
 - These two rinks will be watered during the evening.
 - If weather conditions allow us to restore them, the Municipality will proceed with reopening them.
 - A communication will be issued when the temperature is favourable for the reopening of these two rinks.
- To avoid damaging the ice and to extend the skating period, citizens are asked not to venture onto these surfaces until further notice.
- Here is a reminder of the health measures to be respected, issued by the Quebec government:
 - Limit of 15 people for the Luskville and Quyon skating rinks.
 - Limit of 10 people for the rink at the Davis park.
 - Maintain a distance of two metres from other people at all times.
 - Activities allowed in groups of 8 people maximum.
 - Skating rinks close at 9:00 p.m.
