

Coronavirus (COVID-19): Municipal employees working from home

Municipality of Pontiac

December 11, 2020 – 11:00 a.m.

What you need to know:

 Considering the latest government guidelines announced for the holiday season in the context of COVID-19 in the red zone, municipal employees not working in essential service operations will return to telework as of <u>Thursday</u>, <u>December 17</u>, <u>2020 until Friday</u>, <u>January 8</u>, <u>2021 inclusively</u>;

Maintained services:

- The town planning department;
- Taxation and finance departments;
- The fire department;
- The collection of residual materials;
- Snow removal operations;
- Road works;
- Activities at the wastewater treatment and drinking water filtration plants;
- The two libraries (Luskville, Quyon).

Suspended services:

- Town Hall closed;
- All activities in the three community centres are cancelled (Luskville, Quyon, Quyon Women's Institute);
- Distribution of water testing bottles;
- The Commissioner of Oaths;
- The processing of access to information requests;

The Municipality is keeping its libraries open however, the schedule will be interrupted during the holiday season:

- Luskville (6:30 p.m. to 8:30 p.m.)
 - Wednesday, December 16 Open
 - Wednesday, December 23 Closed
 - Wednesday December 30 Closed
 - Wednesday January 6, 2021 Closed
- Quyon (6:00 p.m. to 8:30 p.m.)
 - Monday, December 14 and Wednesday, December 16 Open
 - Monday, December 21 Open
 - Wednesday, December 23 Closed
 - Monday, December 28 and Wednesday December 30 Closed
 - Monday, January 4, 2021 Closed
 - Wednesday, January 6, 2021 Closed

- Visitors arriving on the premises will be required to wear the face cover and follow the various government health measures that will be indicated.
- Book returns: at all times (24 hours a day, 7 days a week) exclusively in the book drop-off box.

Emergency situation

- In order to maximize the safety of people on the Municipality's roads, any emergency situation outside the municipal office hours must be reported to 911;
 - Examples of emergencies for which to call 911:
 - o Tree fallen on a road;
 - o Dead deer on the road (obstructing vehicle traffic);
 - o Road damaged due to heavy rain, collapse, major erosion;
 - o Icy road.
