Skating rinks: Closing of skating rinks and sanitary measures

What you need to know:

- Considering the mild weather conditions, the Municipality must close its three skating rinks until further notice (Quyon, Luskville and Davis park).
- Please note that when temperatures rise above zero, ice surface conditions become poorer, therefore, citizens are asked not to use the rinks.
- The use of ice rinks in these circumstances creates safety risks for the users, damages the ice surfaces and reduces the time of use of the ice rinks.
- The Municipality will reopen its skating rinks as soon as weather conditions allow it to restore the various ice surfaces.
- Here is a quick reminder of the health measures issued by the Quebec government regarding outdoor leisure and sports activities:
 - Maintain a distance of two metres from other people at all times.
 - Activities must be carried out individually and/or with occupants of the same private residence (e.g. skating, hockey).
 - Limit of 15 people for the Luskville and Quyon skating rinks.
 - Limit of 9 people for the rink at the Davis park.
 - Closing of sites and rinks at 7:30 p.m.
