Telework extension

Considering the latest government guidelines in the context of the COVID-19 virus, municipal employees who are not working within the operations of an essential service, will continue to perform telework until February 8 inclusively. This situation will be reviewed on February 8th as per the next guidelines.

The three skating rinks are now fully operational

- Davis Park:
 138 Soulières Crescent
- Luskville recreational Park: 3206 route 148
- Quyon recreational Park:2 Ferry Rd.

Here are the sanitary measures issued by the Quebec government to be respected:

- Practice free skating and field hockey alone or with members of your immediate family only;
- No field hockey games are allowed;
- Limit of 15 people for the Luskville and Quyon rinks;
- Limit of 9 people for the Davis rink;
- Keep a distance of two metres from other people at all times;

Closing of the skating rinks at 7:30 p.m.

New trails for skiing and snowshoeing

A grant was awarded to the Municipality for the creation of two ski trails and a snowshoe trail, for the acquisition of a tracer and to offer introductory crosscountry skiing workshops.

Work has begun in the two recreational parks and the trails will soon be ready for exploration.

The project offers a free physical activity solution to citizens and a more active life in these more sedentary times. It also allows the Municipality's elementary schools to use the trails to get the youth of the community moving.

The project was submitted in partnership with the Quyon Fitness Centre. The Centre received funding for cross-country skiing equipment. This equipment was loaned to St-Marie school to allow students to discover the joys of winter.

The TAACoMobile arrives in the Municipality!

The TAACoMobile refrigeration unit is coming to the Municipality of Pontiac!

The TAACoMOBILE project is a mobile refrigeration unit. Since July 2020, it offers the elderly population and their families the opportunity to buy fresh fruits and vegetables from local farmers near their homes.

This service provides an information hub for seniors, caregivers and their families and helps improve quality of life while breaking isolation and remoteness. This allows seniors to remain in their living environments, as we bring support, accompaniment, and healthy food closer to them.
