

Coronavirus (COVID-19): Municipal council meeting, August 25, 2020

What you should know:

- The next municipal council meeting will be held, as scheduled, on Tuesday, August 25,
 2020; its format will be changed however, and the public will be able to attend.
- In order to comply with government directives, thus avoiding any type of public gathering, this next council meeting will be held between **via teleconference**.
- Citizens who are interested in attending this session must before <u>12:00 p.m. on Tuesday</u>, August 25, 2020:
 - Submit their presence by email: info@municipalitepontiac.ca;
 - Submit their questions in the same email.
- The Municipality will send an invitation by email only to citizens who will have submitted their presence.
- For technical reasons and good order:
 - Council will only answer questions from citizens who are present.
 - Citizens will not be able to speak; reason for which they must submit their questions in advance.
- For the sake of transparency, the session will be recorded and published on the Municipality's Website.
- The Quebec Minister of Health and Social Services recommends this procedure in order to minimize any risk of propagation.
