

Coronavirus (COVID-19): Total ban on fires

Municipality of Pontiac

May 21, 2020 - 9:00 a.m.

What you should know :

- The SOPFEU, (Société de protection des forêts contre le feu) the organization responsible for the prevention, detection and suppression of forest fires in Quebec, tells us that the flammability index is **extreme**.
- **Consequently, all fires** within the Municipality are now <u>**BANNED**</u>, in accordance with section 10.9 of the standardized bylaw 18-RM-05:

[...] No burning is allowed when the winds exceed fifteen (15) km/h or when the flammability index is «extreme», according to « SOFPEU ». [...] It is the responsibility of the organization responsible to verify such conditions. The SOPFEU is considered, for the purposes of this bylaw, to be the organization of reference and may be contacted by dialing 1-800-567-1206 or at www.sopfeu.qc.ca

• Furthermore, this ban aims to preserve the operational capacity of the SOPFEU and that of municipal fire departments during the pandemic, by limiting the spread of the virus when firefighters respond to emergencies.
