## **Skating rinks: All three rinks are now operational**

Municipality of Pontiac

January 26, 2021 – 3:00 p.m.

### **What you need to know:**

- Weather conditions allowed the Municipality to rehabilitate the ice surface of the Luskville skating rink.
- The Municipality's three skating rinks are now reopened.
  - Davis Park: 138, Soulières Cr.
  - Luskville Recreational Park : 3206, Hwy 148
  - Quyon Recreational Park: 2, Ferry Rd.
- Here are the sanitary measures to be respected, issued by the Quebec government:
  - Practice free skating and field hockey alone or with members of your immediate family only.
  - Hockey games are not allowed.
  - Limit of 15 people for the Luskville and Quyon skating rinks.
  - Limit of 9 people for the rink at the Davis park.
  - Maintain a distance of two metres from other people at all times.
  - Closing of sites and rinks at 7:30 p.m.
