

# Coronavirus (COVID-19): Reopening of municipal services

Municipality of Pontiac

July 27, 2020 – 10:00 a.m.

### **TOWN HALL**

- The Town Hall, located at 2024 route 148, is reopening two of its departments (Taxation and Urban planning) by appointment only as of Monday, August 3, 2020.
- However, the Municipality is asking its citizens to prioritize, as much as possible, remote services, that is:
  - By phone: 819 455-2401;
  - By email: info@municipalitepontiac.ca;
  - o By mail: 2024, route 148 Pontiac (Québec) J0X 2G0;
  - Deposit in the mailbox at the Town Hall.
- Appointments <u>must</u> have been requested in advance by phone 819-455-2041:
  - Taxation: on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays.
  - Urban Planning: on Tuesdays and Thursdays.
- Citizens without an appointment will be denied service.
- The 2-metre social distancing, hand washing and <u>wearing a face cover, will be mandatory</u> at all times. A disinfection station will be available at the entrance and indications will be put in place reminding you of the instructions.
- The Municipality has set the maximum indoor capacity at the Town Hall at 5 people; citizens in excess of 5 will be instructed to wait outside.

## LIBRARIES

- The Municipality will reopen its two libraries on <u>Wednesday, August 5, 2020</u>. Hours of operation have been changed as follows, until further notice:
  - Luskville: Wednesday 6:30 pm 8:30 pm
  - Quyon: Monday and Wednesday 6 pm 8:30 pm
- Visitors arriving on the premises **must wear the face cover** and follow the various government health measures that will be indicated on site.

#### **COMMUNITY CENTRES**

- The three Community centres will be open to the public as of Saturday, August 1, 2020.
- The public will once again be able to rent halls at the Luskville and Quyon Community centres as well as the Quyon Women's Institute
- However, citizens <u>must comply with the health measures</u> imposed by the government, on the day of the event <u>and to provide all the necessary equipment</u> to do so (hand and surface disinfectants, etc.).
- <u>The Municipality reserves the right</u> to cancel the rental at any time in the event that new government measures prevent or would be highly likely to prevent the possibility of holding a gathering on the day of the event.
