Coronavirus (COVID-19): Ban on open fires

Municipality of Pontiac

April 27, 2020 – 2:00 p.m.

What you should know:

- All fires in or near the forest are now **BANNED** in the Municipality.
- This ban is issued by the government and applies to all of the Outaouais region but also for the regions of Montérégie, Estrie, Mauricie, National Capital, Laurentides, Lanaudière, Chaudière-Appalaches, Quebec-centre, Laval and Montreal.
- This ban aims to preserve the operational capacity of the SOPFEU and that of municipal fire
 departments during the pandemic, by limiting the spread of the virus when firefighters respond to
 emergencies.
- The recommendation issued by the Municipality last week not to make open fires in or near the forest is now a ban.
