CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19): Cancellation of activities and events

What you should know:

- The latest government measures announced on Tuesday, September 22, 2020, placing the <u>Outaouais</u> region in the <u>Orange Alert Zone</u>, bring restrictions on unnecessary social contact. For example, gatherings have been restricted to a maximum of 25 people for activities held in indoor and outdoor public places.
- Consequently, due to this government obligation, the Municipality had to <u>cancel the Pontiac Country</u>
 <u>Fair</u> which was organized in collaboration with the National Capital Commission (NCC) and which was scheduled from October 10 to 12 of this year.
- In addition, the Municipality is **cancelling all bookings** involving more than 25 people in its community centers until further notice.
