### Reopening of the Town Hall on August 3, 2020

- The Town Hall, located at 2024 route 148, is reopening two of its departments (Taxation and Urban planning) by appointment only as of Monday, August 3, 2020.
- However, the Municipality is asking its citizens to prioritize remote services as much as possible, that is:
  - By phone: 819 455-2401;
  - By email: <a href="mailto:info@municipalitepontiac.ca">info@municipalitepontiac.ca</a>;
  - By mail: 2024, route 148, Pontiac (Qc) JoX 2Go;
  - Deposit in the mailbox at the Town Hall.
- Appointments <u>must</u> have been requested in advance by phone 819-455-2401:
  - o Taxation: on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays.
  - Urban Planning: on Tuesdays and Thursdays.
- Citizens without an appointment will be denied service.

The 2-metre social distancing, hand washing and wearing a face cover, will be mandatory at all times. A disinfection station will be available at the entrance and indications will be put in place reminding you of the instructions.

### Reopening of community Reopening of libraries centres

The Municipality will reopen its three Community centres as of Saturday, August 1, 2020.

The public will once again be able to rent halls at the Luskville and Quyon Community centres as well as the Quyon Women's Institute.

However, citizens must comply with the health measures imposed by the government, on the day of the event. The Municipality reserves the right to cancel the rental at any time in the event that new government measures prevent or would be highly likely to prevent the possibility of holding a gathering on the day of the event. To rent a hall, citizens are invited to follow the usual procedure which is to fill out the form requesting the rental, verify the availability of the hall by calling 819-455-2401, and paying for the said rental as well as the security deposit in advance to secure the booking.

The Municipality will reopen its libraries in Luskville and Quyon on Wednesday, August 5, 2020. Hours of operation have been changed as follows, until further notice:

Wednesday: 6:30 pm - 8:30 pm

### **Quyon**

Monday and Wednesday: 6 pm - 8:30 pm

Visitors arriving on the premises must wear the face cover and follow the various government health measures that will be indicated.


