

Coronavirus (COVID-19): Extension of telework for municipal employees

Municipality of Pontiac

January 8, 2020 – 3:00 p.m.

What you need to know:

 Considering the latest government guidelines in the context of COVID-19, municipal employees not working in essential service operations will continue to telework <u>until</u> <u>February 8 inclusively. However, this situation is subject to change as the situation</u> <u>evolves;</u>

Maintained services:

- The town planning department;
- Taxation and finance departments;
- The fire department;
- The collection of residual materials;
- Snow removal operations;
- Road works;
- Activities at the wastewater treatment and drinking water filtration plants;
- The two libraries (Luskville, Quyon);
- The Commissioner for Oaths (resumes on January 11, 2021);
- The processing of Access to Information requests (resumes on January 11, 2021).

Suspended services:

- Town Hall closed;
- All activities in the three community centres are cancelled (Luskville, Quyon, Quyon Women's Institute);
- Distribution of water testing bottles;
- The Commissioner of Oaths;
- The processing of access to information requests;

Payment of taxes, permits or other:

Citizens are asked to make their payment of taxes, permits and/or any other payment as follows:

- <u>By Internet</u> via a banking institution:
 - Payment of taxes:
 - You must ensure that you enter the numbers 82030 followed by the letter F and your 10-digit identification number, for a total of 16 spaces in order for your <u>payment</u> to reach us properly.
 - Payment for permits:
 - You must ensure that you enter the numbers 82030 followed by the letter F and your 10-digit identification number, for a total of 16 spaces in order for your payment to reach us properly.
 - You must then send an email to <u>normandin.valerie@municipalitepontiac.ca</u> and include the following information:
 - Your name and address
 - The date of your payment by Internet
 - Your permit number
- By cheque: citizens can deposit or send their cheque in the post office box located at the entrance of City Hall located at 2024, route 148, Pontiac (Quebec) J0X 2G0;
- <u>Citizens who are unable to pay their taxes in one of these ways are invited to contact</u> us so that we can make arrangements for payment: 819 455-2401.

Libraries:

The Municipality maintains its library services but only for the contactless lending counter.

- As a result, citizens cannot circulate in libraries, use computers or select documents from the shelves.

- Citizens are invited to reserve their documents with the library team and pick them up by appointment:

- Citizens are invited to use the book chutes for the return of documents.
- The interlibrary loan service remains available.

Emergency situation

- In order to maximize the safety of people on the Municipality's roads, any emergency situation outside the municipal office hours must be reported to 911;
 - Examples of emergencies for which to call 911:
 - o Tree fallen on a road;
 - o Dead deer on the road (obstructing vehicle traffic);
 - o Road damaged due to heavy rain, collapse, major erosion;
 - o Icy road.
