TOWN HALL

- The Municipality would like to remind you that it has reopened two of its departments over a month ago.
- As of last August, the taxation and urban planning departments are available <u>by appointment</u> <u>only</u>; this system works very well, and the Municipality thanks you for your collaboration.
- Citizens should prioritize, as much as possible, remote services, that is:
 - By phone: 819 455-2401;
 - By email: info@municipalitepontiac.ca;
 - By mail: 2024, route 148 Pontiac (Québec) J0X 2G0;
 - Deposit in the mailbox at the Town Hall.
- Appointments must have been requested in advance by phone 819-455-2401:
 - Taxation: on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays.
 - Urban Planning: on Tuesdays and Thursdays.
- Citizens without an appointment <u>will be denied service</u>.
- The 2-metre social distancing, hand washing and wearing a face cover will be mandatory at
 all times. A disinfection station will be available at the entrance and indications will be put in
 place reminding you of the instructions.

• The Municipality has set the maximum indoor capacity at the Town Hall at 5 people; citizens in excess of 5 will be instructed to wait outside.

LIBRARIES

- The Municipality has reopened its two libraries to the public on Wednesday, August 5, 2020.
 Hours of operation have been changed as follows, until further notice:
 - Luskville: Wednesday 6:30 pm 8:30 pm
 - Quyon: Monday and Wednesday 6 pm 8:30 pm
- Visitors arriving on the premises <u>must wear the face cover</u> and follow the various government health measures that will be indicated on site.

COMMUNITY CENTRES

- The three Community centres have been reopened as of Saturday, August 1, 2020.
- The public will once again be able to rent halls at the Luskville and Quyon Community centres as well as the Quyon Women's Institute.
- However, citizens <u>must comply with the health measures</u> imposed by the government, on the day of the event <u>and provide all the necessary equipment</u> to do so (hand and surface disinfectants, etc.).
- <u>The Municipality reserves the right</u> to cancel the rental at any time in the event that new government measures prevent or would be highly likely to prevent the possibility of holding a gathering on the day of the event.
