4. RENTAL OF MACHINERY AND HEAVY EQUIPMENT WITH OR WITHOUT AN OPERATOR

WHEREAS the Public Works Department plans on profiling nearly 6 km of ditches;

WHEREAS the Public Works Department plans on replacing about 30 culverts in 2019;

WHEREAS the Public Works Department must have at its disposal different heavy equipment and at different times such as trucks, a second excavator, a backhoe, a grader, a water truck and several other equipment to execute the work in a safe and effective fashion:

WHEREAS the cost of equipment rental should be more than \$25,000 and less than \$100,000;

THEREFORE, it is moved by Councillor, Mr. Scott McDonald and seconded by Councillor, Mrs. Leslie-Anne Barber.


AND RESOLVED THAT the Public Works Department proceed with a call for tenders by invitation for the rental of machinery and heavy equipment.

5. <u>AWARDING OF CONTRACT 19-TP-003A- COLLECTION OF</u> RESIDUAL MATERIAL

WHEREAS the call for tenders made by the Municipality to renew the mandate for the collection of residual material;





WHEREAS the council has determined that a 3-year contract with the option to renew an extra year is desirable;

WHEREAS the Municipality of Pontiac made call for proposals on the SEAO site and has received 3 proposals within the prescribed time-frame;

WHEREAS the 3 proposals in the following amounts (taxes included);

WHEREAS Septik Allen 9206-9467 Québec Inc. submitted a bid that contains several major elements of non-compliance;

WHEREAS the two other bidders submitted compliant bids;

WHEREAS the company « Lanthier R.L. Sanitary Service » is the most advantageous compliant bid for the Municipality;

THEREFORE, it is moved by Councillor, Mrs. Susan McKay and seconded by Councillor, Mr. Scott McDonald.

AND RESOLVED THAT the Council mandates 2963-2072 Québec Inc. (Lanthier R.L. Sanitary Service) for the collection of residual materials in the amount submitted for a period of three years and a possible extension of one year.

IT IS ALSO RESOLVED THAT the necessary funds to finance this service come from the general fund and are equally allocated between the two budget items 02-451-12-446 and 02-452-12-446.

FINALLY, IT IS RESOLVED THAT the Council mandates the Director of Infrastructure and Public Works, Mr. Alain Bourgeois, to sign the contract with Lanthier R.L. Sanitary Service.
