orange status

With the latest government measures released on Tuesday, September 22, 2020, placing the Outaouais region in the Orange Alert Zone, the Municipality of Pontiac is ready for any eventuality.

Municipal staff could quickly resume teleworking depending on further government directives. Should this prove to be the case, Municipality will continue to provide essential services (Fire Department, collection of residual material, snow removal operations, roadwork, wastewater treatment and drinking water filtration). Taxation and Urban Planning services will be reduced and will only be available via e-mail, phone or mail.

However, this is not yet the case,

the new Orange Zone measures restrictions introduce on unnecessary social contact. example, gatherings were restricted to a maximum of 25 people for indoor and outdoor activities held in public places.

Consequently, the Municipality is reservations cancelling all involving an activity of more than 25 people in its community centres until further notice.

In addition, due to this government obligation, the Municipality had to cancel the Pontiac Country Fair which was organized in collaboration with the National Capital Commission (NCC) and which was scheduled from October 10 to 12, 2020.
