# SECTION 1

For the execution of the 2017 budget, the general property tax rate (variable tax rates), investment tax rates, loan and others, services tax rates and compensations will be levied according to the following chart:

#### **SECTION 2 METHOD OF PAYMENT**

Method of payment of taxes and compensations provided in the present by-law are as follows:

- 1) all tax or compensation invoices for which the total does not exceed \$300.00, must be paid in one installment on March 1st, 2017
- all tax or compensation invoices for which the total reaches or exceeds \$300.00, 2) the debtor has the right to pay the invoice in one or three installments as follows:

Three equal installments:

- The first installment must be paid by March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2017 The second installment must be paid by June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2017

- The third installment must be paid by October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2017

# **SECTION 3** Taxes and compensations are payable at the Director General's office situated at 2024 Route 148, Pontiac.

## SECTION 4 <u>INTEREST RATES</u>

All accounts owing to the municipality bear interest at a rate of THIRTEEN PERCENT (13%) per annum from the deadline at which they must be paid. However, only outstanding amounts on each installment required bear interest.

### **SECTION 5**

In accordance with article 250.1 of the Act Representing Municipal Taxation, this Council decrees the application of a penalty on tax invoices not exceeding .5% of the outstanding principal for every month following its expiration, up to 5% per annum on due accounts.

# SECTION 6 CHEQUES WITHOUT FUNDS

When a cheque is remitted to the Municipality and payment is refused by the financial institution, administration fees of TWENTY DOLLARS (\$20.00) will be claimed from the drawer in addition to any interests.

# SECTION 7 COMING INTO FORCE

The present by-law will come into force in accordance with the law.
