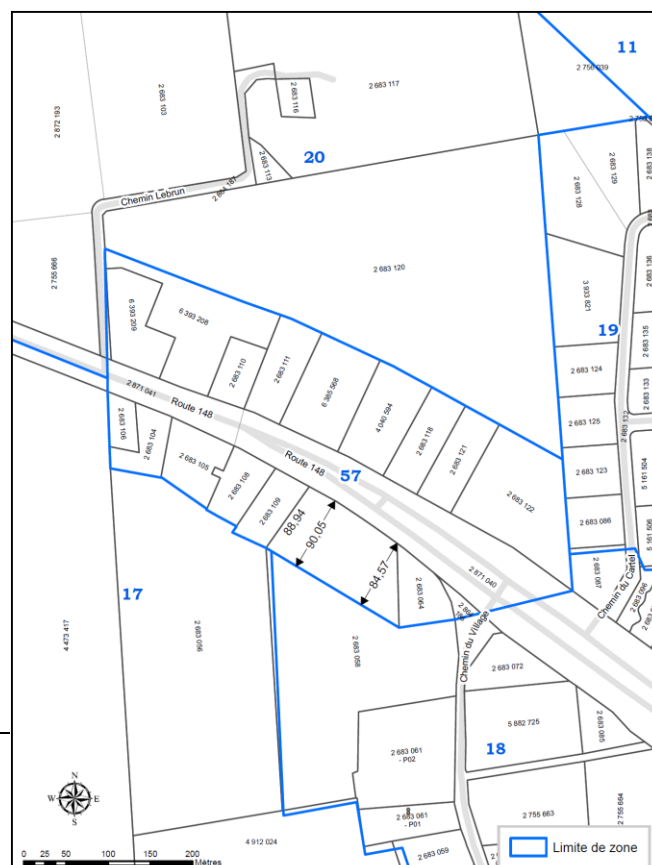
**TO THE CITIZENS OF THE

Interested in the following draft bylaw:

“DRAFT BYLAW NUMBER 177-01-01-2021, ENTITLED “FIRST DRAFT BYLAW 177-01-01-2021 IN REGARDS TO ZONING IN ORDER TO MODIFY THE COMPLEMENTARY RESIDENTIAL USAGES AND MODIFYING ZONE 18 IN ORDER TO CREATE A ZONE 57 AND A NEW TABLE OF SPECIFICATIONS FOR THIS ZONE”

IS HEREBY GIVEN by the undersigned Director General of the aforesaid Municipality, that:

1. During the meeting held on April 13, 2021, council adopted the first draft bylaw amending the zoning Bylaw No. 177-01, that is the above-mentioned draft bylaw number 177-01-01-2021.
2. The council must replace the public consultation meeting for this draft bylaw by a call for written comments, in accordance with the ministerial order number 2020-079 from the *ministère de la Santé et des Services sociaux* dated October 15, 2020.
3. The draft bylaw and the zoning plan can be consulted on the Municipality’s website: <https://municipalitepontiac.com/en/politiques-et-reglements/>
4. Article one (1) of the draft bylaw concerns all zones, whereas articles two (2) and three (3) concern zone 18 only.



5. The draft bylaw contains provisions specific to a bylaw subjected to referendum approval.
6. Any person can transmit a written comment, by email to urbanisme@municipalitepontiac.ca or by mail to the attention of the Urban Planning Department, 2024 Route 148, Pontiac, Qc J0X 2G0, during a period of 15 days following the publication of this notice. That is, until June 7th, 2021 inclusively.
