PANDEMIC UPDATE AND MUNICIPAL SERVICES

Town Hall closed to the public

Following the latest governmental guidelines regarding the current pandemic situation placing the Outaouais region in the **orange** zone, the Town Hall must remain closed to the public. However, the employees of the Municipality who are not working as part of the operations of an essential service continue to offer you their service to the best of their expertise:

Services suspended

- Town Hall closed;
- All activities in the three community centres are cancelled (Luskville, Quyon, Quyon Women's Institute);
- The distribution of bottles for water testing.

Services maintained

- The two libraries in the Luskville and Quyon areas (**fully reopened**);
- Urban Planning Department;
- Taxation and Finance Departments;
- Fire Department;
- Collection of residual materials;
- Road work;
- Activities at the wastewater treatment plant and drinking water filtration plant;
- The Commissioner of Oaths;
- The processing of access to information requests (partially);

Appointment to the Executive Committee - Centraide Outaouais



The Mayor of the Municipality Mrs. Joanne Labadie, was appointed representative of the MRC des Collines-de-l'Outaouais on the Executive Committee for Municipal Affairs of Centraide Outaouais on May 20, 2020, at the MRC Council of Mayors meeting.

Centraide Outaouais wished to establish an executive council for municipal affairs composed of elected officials representing the MRCs of the Outaouais.

Each of the MRCs is aware of the challenges faced by each of their communities and their expertise will allow them to respond adequately to these different issues.

The committee's mandate will be to share initiatives and strategies for the development of a fundraising campaign within the MRCs.

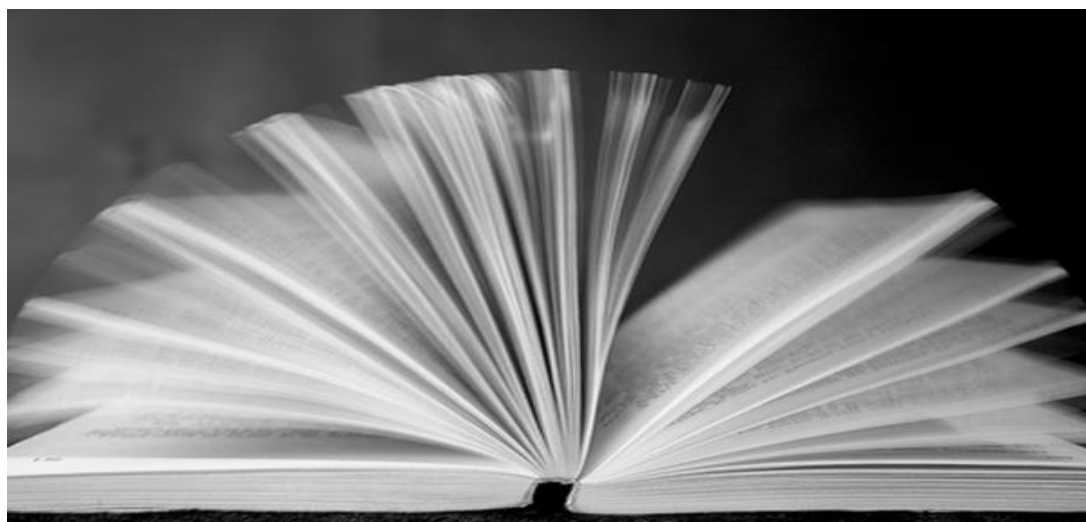

The purpose of these courtesy notes is to indicate to citizens the elements of "non-compliance" that will have been noted concerning the disposal of residual materials.

The Municipality will begin distributing the courtesy notes as of July 12, 2021.
