Coronavirus (COVID-19): Measures being relaxed

What you need to know:

Resumption of bookings:

- Considering the various relaxations to come in stages presented by the Government of Quebec, the Municipality of Pontiac is allowing the booking of its infrastructures to resume, in accordance with the applicable sanitary guidelines:
 - Phased into the yellow zone (as of June 14, 2021):
 - Rental of halls (interior) for events or social activities: Maximum allowed is occupants of 2 residences (social distancing and mask).
 - Rental of outdoor sports facilities (sports and leisure): Maximum group of 12 people (sports practice with brief contact, social distancing and mask).
 - Phased into the green zone (possibly as of June 28, 2021):
 - Rental of halls (indoor) for events or social activities: Maximum allowed is 25 people (social distancing and mask).
 - Rental of outdoor sports facilities (sports and leisure): Maximum allowed is a group of 25 people (sports practice with brief contact, social distancing and mask).

- Bookings:

Maintaining telework:

 The Town Hall must remain closed to the public. However, the Municipality's employees who are not working in the operations of an essential service continue to offer you their service to the best of their ability.

Services maintained:

- The two libraries, in Luskville and Quyon (complete re-opening);

- Taxation and finance departments;
- The fire department;
- The collection of residual materials;
- Road works;
- Activities at the wastewater treatment and drinking water filtration plants;
- The Commissioner for Oaths;
- The processing of Access to Information requests (partially).

Suspended services:

- Town Hall closed;
- Distribution of water testing bottles.

Payment of taxes, permits or other:

- Citizens are asked to make their payment of taxes, permits and/or any other payment as follows:
 - By Internet via a banking institution:
 - Payment of taxes:
 - You must ensure that you enter the numbers 82030 followed by the letter F and your 10-digit identification number, for a total of 16 spaces in order for your <u>payment</u> to reach us properly.
 - Payment for permits:
 - You must ensure that you enter the numbers 82030 followed by the letter F and your 10-digit identification number, for a total of 16 spaces in order for your payment to reach us properly.
 - You must then send an email to <u>normandin.valerie@municipalitepontiac.ca</u> and include the following information:
 - Your name and address
 - The date of your payment by Internet
 - Your permit number
 - <u>By cheque</u>: citizens can deposit or send their cheque in the post office box located at the entrance of City Hall located at 2024, route 148, Pontiac (Quebec) J0X 2G0;
 - <u>Citizens who are unable to pay their taxes in one of these ways are invited to</u> <u>contact us so that we can make arrangements for payment: 819 455-2401.</u>
