Coronavirus (COVID-19): Municipal council meeting, July 6, 2021

What you need to know:

- The next municipal council meeting will be held, as scheduled, on **Tuesday**, **July 6**, **2021**, at **7:30 p.m.**; its format will be changed however, and the <u>public will be able to attend</u>.
- In order to comply with government directives, thus avoiding any type of public gathering, this next council meeting will be held between <u>via teleconference</u>.
- Citizens who are interested in attending this session must before <u>12:00 p.m. on Tuesday</u>, <u>July 6, 2021</u>:
 - Submit their presence by email: staubin.lucie@municipalitepontiac.ca;
 - Submit their questions in the same email.
- The Municipality will send an invitation by email only to citizens who will have submitted their presence.
- For the sake of transparency, the session will be recorded and published on the Municipality's Website.
- The Quebec Minister of Health and Social Services recommends this procedure in order to minimize any risk of propagation.
