

Since the beginning of the pandemic, we all know that this situation has brought its share of challenges to the operations of the municipal administration, but this pandemic has also brought many positive changes for the Municipality.

First, we were obliged to stop distributing the paper edition of the newsletter and the response from citizens has been very positive, as the number of subscriptions has increased significantly, with over 61 new subscribers in less than 2 months!

The pandemic situation has allowed us to bring the Municipality up to date with the use of new technologies.

A new newsletter concept, but also a new website, a new image and over the next few months, the Municipality will take another step with the integration of a new technological platform to increase accessibility to municipal services for citizens. This is the platform « **Voilà** ».

With this « **Voilà** » platform, citizens will be at the heart of municipal services and will be able to create his or her own profile with the administration. Communication between the citizen and the Municipality will therefore be greatly facilitated. « **Voilà** » will allow you to centralize all municipal services in a "Personalized Citizen File". For example, you will have the possibility to register with the Recreation Department to find out what the upcoming activities will be. You will also be able to access your tax account or make online requests. Consequently, you will have to create your user account in the platform, according to your needs. By subscribing to the « **Voilà** » portal, you will have access to information at your fingertips.

So today we are pleased to launch the allnew concept of your Municipal Bulletin. Although this is the first edition, it is important to note that the August edition is the last before the election is called on September 17, 2021. The publication of the October edition will continue in the same format, but the content will be focused more on the municipal election in order to keep you well-informed of its progress.

Democracy is at the heart of our priorities; let's encourage political involvement! I invite you to run for office; your voice makes a difference. We need elected officials because they represent the population and make decisions on the orientations and priorities of the Municipality!

UPDATE ON THE PANDEMIC AND MUNICIPAL SERVICES

Town Hall – progressive return considered

Following the latest government directives regarding the current pandemic situation, the Municipality is considering a gradual return of its employees to the Town Hall. This reintegration will not take place before the start of the new school year this fall, as the Municipality intends to remain cautious, facing the possibility of the arrival of a new wave. Although no date has yet been confirmed, the Municipality will keep you informed of the situation.

Municipal employees who do not work in the operations of an essential service continue to provide service to you to the best of their ability:

Phased into the green zone (currently in effect):

- Rental of halls (indoor) for events or social activities: Maximum allowed is 25 people (social distancing and mask).
- Rental of outdoor sports facilities (sports and leisure): Maximum allowed is a group of 50 people (sports practice with brief contact, social distancing and mask).
- The Municipality invites you to consult the applicable government guidelines.

Resumption of bookings

 Considering the various relaxation guidelines to come in stages presented by the Government of Quebec, the Municipality of Pontiac is allowing the booking of its infrastructures to resume, in accordance with the applicable sanitary guidelines:



Bookings

Step 1: Consult the Municipality's <u>Municipal infrastructure rent-</u> <u>al policy</u>, in which states that **you are responsible for cleaning the premises after use**, failing which the Municipality may have the work done at the tenant's expense.

Step 2: Complete the online <u>reservation form</u> in which you agree, among other things, to respect the government's health guidelines.

The guidelines will be published on the Municipality's website.



A section of de la Montagne Road, which is in the Luskville area, will be completely closed to traffic as of Monday, August 2, 2021 until October 5, 2021.

The Municipality will carry out major works consisting of excavation, changing culverts and paving the road.

The work will be done by Les Entreprises G.N.P.

The targeted section of road for repair work is located between 1874 to 1887 de la Montagne Road.

Access to residences will be maintained on both sides of the work area.


The detour will be via the following roads: East on Elm Road, North on Terry Fox Road, East on Bailie Road, North on Daly Road, West on Kelly Road, North on Hollow Glen Road, West on de la Montagne Road.

For the safety of road users and workers, compliance with the signage that will be put in place is essential.

We will notify you of the reopening of this section of de la Montagne Road as soon as possible.

The Municipality invites citizens to address their questions and/or comments to its Public Works Department in order to keep the work running smoothly.

Élections 2021 ELECTORAL STAFF REQUIRED - 2021 ELECTION
