What you need to know:

- On November 7th, you will be invited to vote for your new warden of the MRC des Collines-de-l'Outaouais!
- In the past, the MRC Warden was chosen from among the mayors who sat on the Council of Mayors. At its meeting held on February 20, 2020, the Council of Mayors of the MRC des Collines unanimously adopted a bylaw according to which the choice of the warden will henceforth be made by universal suffrage. This by-law cannot be repealed.
- The warden is a representative not only of the mayors, but also of the citizens of his MRC. He or she represents them on issues that affect several municipalities. The role of the warden allows several municipalities to speak with one voice on common issues.
- You will be called to vote for the warden at the same time as your mayor and municipal councillor vote, on November 7, 2021.
- If you live in the Municipality of Pontiac, but own one or more properties elsewhere in the MRC des Collines-de-l'Outaouais, you must vote for the warden in the municipality where your permanent residence is located.
