## Coronavirus (COVID-19): Regular municipal council meeting on September 14, 2021

## What you need to know:

- The next municipal council meeting will be held on Tuesday, September 14, 2021 at 7:30
   p.m.; its format will be changed however, and the public will be able to attend.
- In order to comply with government directives, thus avoiding any type of public gathering, this
  next council meeting will be held between <u>via teleconference</u>.
- Citizens who are interested in attending this session must before <u>12:00 p.m. on Tuesday</u>, <u>September 14, 2021</u>:

  - Submit their questions in the same email.
- The Municipality will send an invitation by email only to citizens who will have submitted their presence.
