Coronavirus (COVID-19): Update of municipal services

What you need to know:

- As a result of the latest government guidelines regarding the rapid evolution of the current pandemic situation, the Town Hall had to close its access to the public again as of December 22, until further notice.
- The government has also suspended, as of December 31, the public face-to-face Council meetings, for an indeterminate period.
- Certain municipal employees, not working in the operations of an essential service, will be teleworking for an indeterminate period.
- This situation is subject to change according to the progression of government guidelines.
- The majority of municipal services are maintained:
 - The town planning department
 - Taxation and finance departments
 - The fire department
 - The collection of residual materials
 - Snow removal operations
 - Road works
 - Activities at the wastewater treatment and drinking water filtration plants
 - The Commissioner for Oaths
 - The processing of access to information requests
 - The two libraries in the Luskville and Quyon areas according to the following schedule and sanitary guidelines:
