POWER FAILURE: Information

What you should know:

- The Municipality wishes to inform you that, following the storm on Saturday, May 21st, the electrical network was affected in several sectors of the Municipality as well as in several regions.
- Hydro Quebec teams are currently working to restore power, sector by sector.
- Wires have fallen in several areas and are still live. DANGER DO NOT APPROACH THE WIRES.
- The fact that many trees and/or branches have fallen due to the storm, we ask that you <u>avoid burning</u> <u>branches</u> at this time, and for the next week. This will reduce the number of calls to the fire department, i.e. for smoke reports.
- People who wish to obtain drinking water can do so from a fountain installed outside, in front of the building located at 5 Egan Street as well as from the garden hose at the Quyon Women's Institute building, located at 885 Clarendon Street in the Village of Quyon.
- Firefighters are at the Luskville fire station to provide access to the Luskville Community Centre for those who either need bottled water, to use the washroom or to charge their cell phone between 7:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m., until further notice. The community center will be available to you until power is restored.
