## Making a change of address for your municipal tax bill

When purchasing a property or following a new construction, please fill out the Request for Change of Mailing Address form [www.municipalitepontiac.ca](http://www.municipalitepontiac.ca) under the 'Forms and Permit Applications' section to report your change of mailing address, or contact Mrs. Ramsay [ramsay.louise@municipalitepontiac.ca](mailto:ramsay.louise@municipalitepontiac.ca) as soon as possible so that we can redirect your municipal tax bill to the correct location.

## Municipal taxes – 2nd payment/instalment

We wish to remind you that in order to avoid additional charges of 13% (interest) and 5% (penalties), the second instalment for the payment of your municipal taxes must be **received by the Municipality no later than June 15, 2022**.

**NOTE:** There is a delay of a few days for the processing of your payment through a banking institution. Please ensure that your payment is made sufficiently in advance to avoid additional charges.

### Method of payment:

#### 1. By Internet via a banking institution:

You must ensure that you enter the numbers 82030 followed by the letter F and your 10-digit number on your tax bill, for a total of 16 spaces, in order for your payment to reach us properly.

#### 2. By cheque:

Citizens can either drop off their cheque in person at the Town Hall, or in the mailbox located at the entrance of the Town Hall, or send it by mail to 2024, Route 148, Pontiac (Qc) J0X 2G0.

## UPDATE ON MUNICIPAL SERVICES AND THE PANDEMIC SITUATION

Following the latest government guidelines regarding the removal of the obligation to wear masks in most public places as of May 14, 2022, the Municipality wishes to inform you that the wearing of masks is now optional at the Town Hall, subject to the following exceptions:

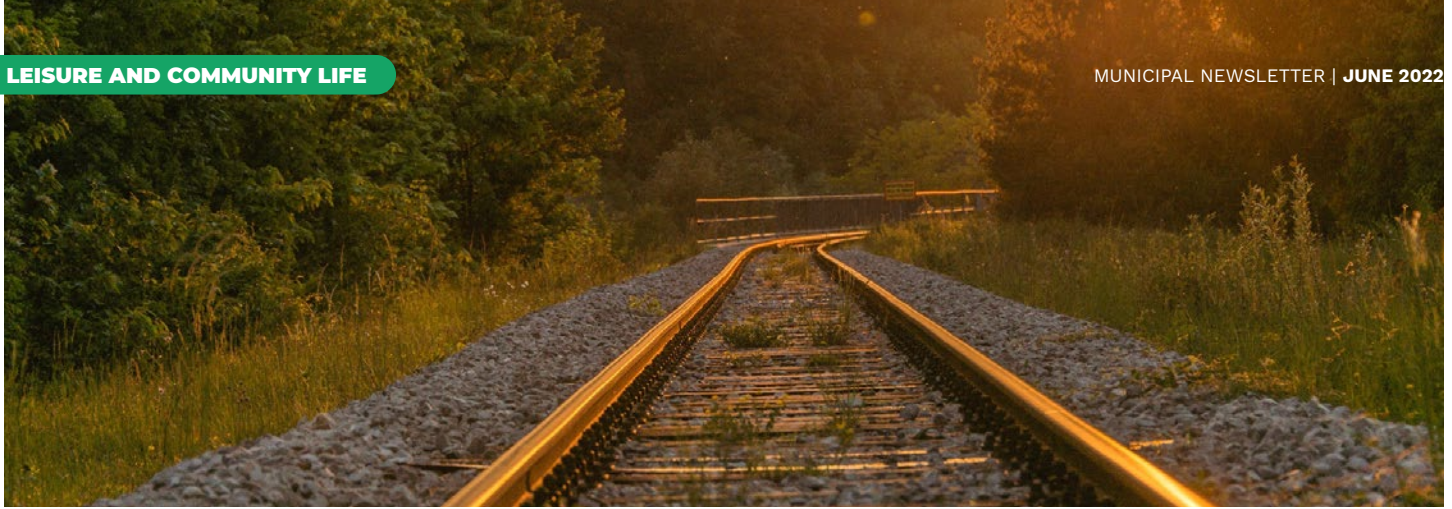
- You must wear a mask for 5 days after isolation when you have had COVID-19;
- You must wear a mask for 10 days if you live with someone who has COVID-19.

Note that wearing a mask is still recommended:

- If you suffer from a respiratory illness or immunosuppression;
- If you are in the presence of a vulnerable or immunocompromised person;
- When it is difficult to keep a distance from others.

This situation is subject to change in accordance with government guidelines.

## Rental of municipal infrastructures

The request for booking a community centre or sports grounds is **mandatory for each activity**.

The [Policy on the Rental of Municipal Facilities](#) was updated and adopted by the municipal council on May 10, 2022.

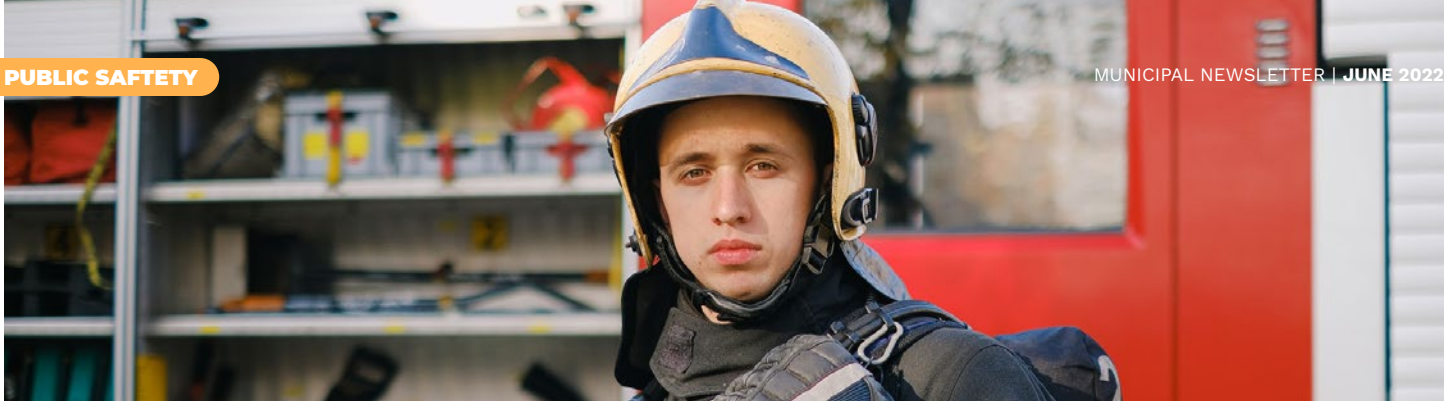
We invite you to **read the Policy before proceeding with your application**, as it includes many important elements such as rules, operation, prices, etc.

Please note that the halls or sports grounds are considered reserved only upon full payment to the Municipality.

A \$200 security deposit is mandatory, except for non-profit organizations (NPO) recognized by the Municipality. (The security deposit is returned to you by the Finance Department after the event, if all rental conditions have been met by the lessee).

You must go to the front desk at the Town Hall to pick up the key fob **the day before the event**.

The key fob must be **returned** to the Municipality **the day after the event**.
