## **OUTDOOR FIRES:** Burning of branches

## What you should know:

- Further to our communication of May 23rd, asking you to avoid burning branches following the storm of May 21st, the Municipality wishes to inform you that the burning of branches will be permitted during the weekends of June 11th, 12th and 18th, 19th, provided that there are no strong winds.
- Therefore, we invite you to take note of <u>By-law No. 01-04</u> concerning outdoor fires. We wish to remind you that you must respect, among others, the following instructions contained in this by-law:
  - $_{\odot}$  The height of the fire shall not exceed 48 inches, the area shall not exceed 48" x 48".
  - The fire must be under constant supervision by a sober adult.
  - An adequate means of extinction must be provided and available in the vicinity of the fire.
  - You must respect the distance of at least 30 feet from all combustible materials.
- Please note that our firefighters will be on duty at the Luskville fire station during these 2 weekends. For any information during this period, you can contact them at the following number (819) 664-1446.
- A branch collection will be held starting June 20th, for those who cannot burn branches. We ask that you deposit your branches at the roadside before June 20th.
- Pick up may take a few weeks. We therefore ask for your collaboration.
