# What you should know:

- The Municipality wishes to remind you that the collection of bulky items will take place as scheduled during the week of July 20, 2020
- In order to avoid confusion, we have included herein the complete list of items that are accepted and those that are refused.
- The week of July 20<sup>th</sup> is also the week of the household garbage collection.
- The household garbage will be collected according to the usual schedule, that is Monday through Wednesday.

#### ITEMS ACCEPTED

- Bathtub (acrylic or fiberglass)
- Furniture with fabric (couch, armchair)
- Mattress
- Wooden bed frame
- Blinds
- Large plastic items (furniture, toys)
- Garden hose
- Plastic pool filter (empty)
- Pool cover and carpet cut up in 4-foot pieces, rolled up and tied

- Styrofoam, provided it does not contain water
- Artificial Christmas tree
- Wooden furniture
- Bulbs and lamps are accepted in the collection of household waste or bulky items, depending on their size.
- Flat glass (window, patio door, glass and mirror), but must not include the framing. The glass must be broken and put in a cardboard box or an open container.
- Aquarium, the glass must be broken and put in a cardboard box or an open container.
- Pool pump
- Vaccum cleaner

### **ITEMS REFUSED**

- Building materials and waste: wood, door, ceramic, vinyl and other type of floor covering, vinyl and other type of siding, mineral wool, etc.
- Gravel, sand, asphalt
- Soil (contaminated or not)
- Household waste
- Recyclable materials
- Recyclable materials and compostable waste
- Metal bulky items: Metal bathtub, parts and pieces of metal, bed frame, door, metal furniture, tire
  rim, household appliances, hot water tank, air conditioning unit, cooler, barbecue, exercise
  equipment, heat pump, etc.
- Hazardous household waste
- Natural Christmas tree
- Opaque plastic bag
- Tire
- Ashes
- Textiles
- Car parts
- Equipment containing gasoline or oil (lawnmowers, snowblowers, chainsaws)
- Dead animals
- Electronic devices
- Appareils électroniques
- Watercrafts: boat, pedal boat, canoe, kayak, etc.
- Spa
- Gun and amunition
