## **WATER QUYON: Water shut-off advisory**

June 17, 2020 – 5:00 p.m.

### **What you should know:**

- The Municipality of Pontiac is issuing a water shut-off advisory for **Thursday June 18 from 6:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.** for the following roads in Quyon:
  - Clarendon Street (between Egan Street and Ferry roads)
  - St-George Street (between Bruce and St-John St.)
  - Church Street
  - Egan Street
  - 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue
- This notice is issued in connection with sewer repair work on Saint-Andrew and Saint-John Streets.
- Once the water is restored, citizens and establishments connected to the municipal system must boil their water for five (5) minutes before consuming it, for a period of 24 hours, as a preventive measure.
