

INVENTORY NOTICE: Animals and livestock buildings

Municipality of Pontiac

November 17, 2020 – 4:00 p.m.

What you should know:

- The Municipality of Pontiac has started an inventory of agricultural animals and livestock buildings on its territory.
- Owners with lots in an agricultural zone with or without animals will shortly receive a phone call from the urban planning department of the Municipality of Pontiac.
- The inventory has two very distinct purposes:
 - Firstly, make an approximate count of the number of animal units in each farm.
 - Secondly, locate livestock buildings in order to be able to apply the standards relating to separation distances during a new construction or building expansion.
- The Urban Planning Department is considering using this data as part of the analysis of requests made to the *Commission de protection du territoire agricole du Québec (CPTAQ)* or applications for building permits for non-agricultural residential buildings or livestock buildings.
- The Municipality thanks all the citizens who took the time to share the information.
