HEAT WAVE: Reducing the use of potable water

What you should know:

- The Municipality is asking the population to reduce their consumption of potable water for the duration of this heat wave, until Friday, June 26, 2020.
- This measure aims to reduce the impact on the source of potable water and thus ensure a stable and constant supply of potable water.
- Citizens are therefore invited to avoid watering their lawn, install water features/games, washing their vehicle, or filling their pool. The Municipality also suggests putting off laundry or the use of the dishwasher until less busy times of the day.
- Citizen collaboration is crucial: If everyone makes an effort there will be sufficient water for basic needs (preparing meal, etc.)
- For the sectors of the Municipality that use wells: be aware that the water level in the ground is lower than normal and that consequently, overuse of your well could damage your pump or even completely empty your well.
