

REMINDER: Existing regulations concerning ATVs

Municipality of Pontiac

July 27, 2020 – 2 :00 p.m.

- The Municipality wishes to remind citizens of the current bylaw concerning all-terrain vehicles, to ensure the safety of all.
- The Road Safety Code prohibits the circulation of off-road vehicles on public roads (art. 11), as well as municipal regulations (standardized bylaws 19-RM-04 (art. 8.7), 12-RM-03 (art. 5.1).

- It is forbidden to drive on public roads using all-terrain vehicles, with the exception of the following municipal roads, as per by-law 13-09 and an agreement with Pontiac Quad Club:
 - Part of Bradley Road (1.1 km)
 - Part of Kennedy Road (0.1 km)
 - 6th Concession (2.2 km)
 - Wilson Road (1.8 km)
 - Steele Road (10.1 km)
 - Swamp Road (2.9 km)

- Farrel Road (1.7 km)
- Hickey Road (0.9 km)
- O'Reilly/Henderson Road (0.9 km/3.7 km)
- 3rd Concession (3 km)
- Pontiac Road (1.6 km)
- Clarendon Street (1.5 km)
- Murray Road (5.4 km)
- 5th Concession (between Proven and Murray Roads)
- Lac-des-Loups Road at 5th Concession
- Highway 148 intersection with Eardley-Masham Road
- Highway 148 intersection with 5th Concession
- Highway 148 intersection with Murray Road.
- Anyone who contravenes the Act and any regulations in force is liable to a maximum fine of \$1,000.
