HEAT WAVE: Reduction of the use of potable water

What you should know:

- The Municipality asks the population to reduce their consumption of drinking water until further notice due to the current heat wave.
- This measure is intended to reduce the impact on the source of potable water and thus ensure a stable and constant supply of potable water.
- Citizens are therefore invited to avoid watering the lawn, installing water games, washing vehicles or filling swimming pools. The Municipality also suggests postponing laundry or dishwasher use to less busy times of the day.
- Citizen collaboration is crucial: if everyone makes an effort, there will be enough water for basic needs (food preparation, etc.).
- For those in the Municipality using wells: be aware that the water level in the ground is lower than normal and therefore overuse of your well could damage your pump or even dry up your well completely.
- The Municipality will inform you of the lifting of this notice.
